



this may not be practical using hand tools so similar railings can be purchased ready made if preferred.

Apart from the base parts, none of the pieces are glued together yet as it will be easier to apply the realistic brick and paving effects to them prior to assembly.

Once all the parts are cut to size, paint all of the areas where the realistic brick or paving is to be applied using a matt emulsion paint – choose a cement/ mortar colour as this will show in-between the bricks. The railings are painted black.
